



Waterloo County Revolver Association will be hosting a Police Pistol Combat (PPC) club match that is open to anyone who is holster qualified. Competitors will provide their classification via CSSA. New shooters will be temporary High Master until 240 rounds are fired and a classification can be determined.

Matches will be an open 1200 match as well as a Service Revolver/Pistol match. All matches will be fired at a maximum of 25 yards at B27 and B34 targets.

The Service Revolver/Semi-Auto pistol match will consist of 48 rounds fired at 3,7,15 & 25 yards using a B27 target. In the spirit of the match, Custom Colt (or similar) pistols, Smith & Wesson Model 52 & PPC 9s, Sig X5 & X6 etc., will not be allowed. Revolvers should have standard factory barrels, 5" or less. Competitors must use the barricade for support and cover during the kneeling portion of match 4. This match may be fired as many times as the competitor chooses with as many firearms as you like.

The 1200 - PPC Match will consist of 120 rounds fired at 7 and 25 yards using a B27 and B34 targets. Open to both revolvers and semi-auto pistols.

The competitors will score all the targets after all matches have been fired. Competitors will not be allowed to score their own targets. The forward line and equipment rule will be enforced.

The Match date:

Saturday - 28 MAY 2011 . First relay will start at 10:00; registration closes at 12:00

At this point, PPC has been a scarce commodity with several clubs eliminating the discipline all together. The WCRA executive board has sanctioned these dates and activity with the hope that the discipline will continue. If by chance there is an overwhelming desire from the competitors to fire the 1200 - PPC Match from 50 yards, or to go to a 1500 format, adjustments may be made during the course of the season. From my past experience very few of our club members would consider the 50 yard course of fire. In any event, let's wait and see how many shooters attend and we will take it from there. The main objective is to continue the discipline and have fun with old and new friends.

The cost will be \$ 15.00 for the 1200 Match and \$5.00 for Service Match. (Re-shoots - \$2.00 ea)

Awards will be on the Lewis system. For the service match, only one award per competitor. I would love to be able to offer big prizes and lot's of cash, however we will review the level of participation and a determination will be made later in the season.
